Bread Ministry Volunteer

Description

One of the Core Values of Good Shepherd is “Welcome.” As people visit Good Shepherd throughout the year, one way we extend our welcome is to deliver a loaf of fresh baked bread to their home. A Bread Ministry Volunteer is on a rotating list of people who conduct this ministry. The volunteer:

- o Gets a card from the church office with the address of the GSC visitor.
- o Delivers a loaf of bread with a greeting card (provided by the church office).
- ü Some volunteers buy “a nice loaf of bread” from the store... some bake cookies or a pie instead!

Timeframe

- o A volunteer can choose when he or she goes on and off the list.
- o Each volunteer delivers bread 2-3 times per year on average.
- o The activity of the bread ministry is based on the number of visitors, so activity can vary throughout the year.

Training/Qualifications

No special training is required, but people who enjoy baking bread and being a friendly, welcoming face are perfect for this position!
